Activity/Programme Title	<b>New Direction Access to Further Education</b>
Certificated/Non-Certificated	Certificated
Qualification / Level	SQA / SCQF Level 3/4
Activity Description	This course is designed for young people still at School to attend College one day per week, to give them the opportunity to engage with College life with the aim of them progressing on to a full time Access to Further Education Course within Supported Programmes once they have officially left school.
Entry Requirement	This course is designed as a progression course that, if successful, may lead to a supported full time programme. It is designed for young people in their last year of school who have been identified as struggling to keep up with the curriculum and would benefit from a vocationally focused curriculum and enhanced transition. This course is suitable for those young people who may have recently disengaged from school, struggle with academic subjects and who may be at risk of a negative destination or leaving school with little or no qualifications. Working in partnership, College and School will support young people with their individual needs. All places are subject to successful interview and transition information from the School. <b>Support and transport arrangements to be provided by the school.</b>
Content	The emphasis of the programme is on vocational subjects that can lead to progression within Further Education. These vocational areas could include, depending on availability, may include Hair and Beauty, Media, Drama, Horticulture, Hospitality Industries, Craft, Retail, IT.
