



## S1 Parents'/Carers' Evening – Tuesday 20th March 2018

I am pleased to invite you to the school on the evening above **between 4.30pm and 7pm** to discuss your child's progress with the appropriate class teachers. Guidance Principal Teachers will also be available for consultation if not involved in their own subject interviews. Your S1 child may accompany you.

You may book appointments with teachers online using a computer with internet access or a smartphone. If you choose to use the smartphone then appointments can be made automatically, finding the best slots within the times you have specified.

The online booking system can be found at <https://queenannehigh.parentseveningsystem.co.uk/> The system opens for booking on Tuesday March 13<sup>th</sup> and closes on Monday March 19<sup>th</sup>. Both dates are inclusive. You should be aware that teachers are only able to meet with the parents/carers of a maximum of 24 pupils, so it may not be possible to see every subject teacher you wish. If that is the case, please contact your child's Guidance Principal Teacher with the information you are seeking. The Guidance Principal Teacher will find out the information you want from the subject teachers and get back to you.

If you don't have access to a computer with internet access or a smartphone, please contact your child's Guidance Principal Teacher with a list of teachers you'd like to see and we will attempt to book as many of those appointments as possible for you.

Parents'/Carers' evenings are always well attended and I ask that you help us to ensure the appointment system runs smoothly by keeping to each arranged interview time of five minutes. Staff will also be asked to keep interviews within the allocated time.

A plan indicating where each teacher is located will be provided on the evening when you sign in. You may find the advance information below useful in helping you to navigate between appointments.
