The rules and expectations of all in Queen Anne High School are:

- **Ready** to learn
- **Respectful** to others
- **Safe** in all that we do

In these times of heightened risk to our health, behaving in a **safe** manner is now more important than ever. These are not normal times.

All members of the QAHS community have a responsibility for their own personal safety; the safety of others in school; and subsequently, the safety of all other people with whom they may come into contact, i.e.: friends and family.

To protect everyone's health, all pupils and staff must adhere to the physical distancing rules within the school and on the grounds surrounding the school building. A conscious effort should also be made by all to minimise the number of unnecessary physical interactions we have with others and we continue to recommend regular handwashing.

The potential consequences of behaviour that threatens distancing measures, respiratory or tactile hygiene are very serious indeed. Where it is felt that a young person is deliberately and/or repeatedly unable to adhere to safety guidelines, and thus increasing the risk of infection to themselves and others, will be required to complete their learning off-site.
