

Updated SQA information

Thank you to all the parents, carers and pupils who took the time to call or email the school on Tuesday or Wednesday regarding the awarding of exam results. We are aware the lines were extremely busy and not everyone was able to get through to speak to a member of the Senior Leadership Team. For everyone that has left their contact details, someone will be back in touch over the course of the next week when we return to school.

To reassure pupils, parents and carers, as a school we have reviewed all results and our faculties are aware of all of the pupils who have been downgraded from their estimated grade. When staff return next week they will begin the process of reviewing evidence and preparing materials to submit reviews (appeals) for almost all of the pupils who were downgraded. Pupils who still require to give consent for an appeal will be contacted by a member of staff from the school to discuss following our return.

One common question has been regarding course choices for the coming session. Pupils **will not** be re-coursed where their awarded grade has been downgraded from what was estimated to a D or Fail.

Following our return to school next week, if pupils have any concerns regarding course choices or access to college or university, in the first instance please email your guidance teacher who will be able to offer support.
